HOLDS OFFICER ELECTIONS**

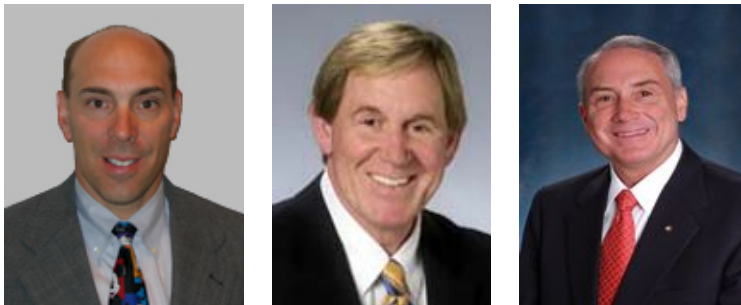
